<b>Descrizione del programma di ricerca</b>	Projects that focus on the unique nature of the issues surrounding people with disabilities are preferable. Researchers who take a multidimensional view in their studies are also desirable. Therefore, the call is open to projects that focus on the relational dimension of People with disabilities, not only concerned with material needs but also with existential, relational, emotional and educational ones; the development of an individualized path to living an independent life; and enhancing and protecting the role of families and caregivers. For instance, projects may cover topics related to: the acquisition and development of specific abilities to recognize and protect the rights of people with disabilities; the organization and management of the relationship between these people and the society in which they live, both in public and in business contexts; the development of new theoretical perspectives about disability and inclusion; the spatial and architectural organization of machinery and settings in the workplaces; food safety and sports regulation.
