Settore scientifico-disciplinare (Scientific-disciplinary field):	HIST-03/A (Contemporary History)
Duration of the contract (max 24 months):	24 months
Profile of the researcher to be recruited:	The researcher must have received the doctoral degree within the last seven years; have significant research experience abroad of at least six months during the doctoral and/or postdoctoral period; have adequate knowledge of English and of at least one second foreign language; and have at least two original publications in international journals (Fascia A Anvur).
Description of the research project on which the postdoctoral researcher will be engaged:	The researcher should develop a project with a comparative, transnational and/or global approach, paying attention to the relational dimensions of historical processes, legal regimes and the organization of power; the interdependencies between economic, political, legal, cultural and social factors; and the circulation, exchange and interconnection of ideas, people, institutions, legal cultures, political models, concepts, rights and goods on a global scale. In particular, the project must focus on one or more of the following thematic areas (PNRR theme: inclusion and cohesion): the ideas and practices of citizenship; the history of rights, with particular attention to collective or group rights (national minorities, social groups, women, etc.) and the conflicts they generate, combining the history of ideas with socio-political history. The project should cover the period after World War I and may extend to the present. It must be based on archival and documentary research as well as on secondary literature.
